




Federal Taxes at Various Gini Coefficients






Federal Transfers at Various Gini Coefficients






Change in the Balance: Taxes Less Transfers






Gini Coefficient for Total and After-Tax Income


Equalizing Effect of the Tax and Transfer System


Inequality Reduction with the Tax and Transfer System
